For developers and investors, this isn't just an environmental risk—it's a financial one, with the potential for entire capital investments to be wiped out before a single ton of carbon is delivered.

Key facts about our Planting Insurance Cover



FACT 1 Covered Perils

Natural hazards (e.g., fire, storms, pest and disease, flood, drought, extreme temperatures, etc.)



FACT 2 Payout type

In cash, to compensate for the per-hectare cost of replanting after a loss (including other associated costs, e.g., labour, equipment, nursery sourcing, etc.)



FACT 3 Policy duration

1 year cover with annual renewal. Longer policy durations are available based on client needs



FACT 4 Claim trigger

A payout is made automatically when certain weather conditions—like a large fire, strong wind or extreme heat—reach a specific level. These conditions are measured using trusted third-party data, so no claims process is needed, resulting in fast claims payouts
